

Suggested Service for Communion to Shut-Ins

- Call each individual to set a time to take communion
- Take the Bulletin for that day to leave with the individual
- Take a copy of the Sermon to leave (if one is printed and available)
- Take a bible to read one of the scriptures from the church service that day
- Have your own copy of the bulletin to use during the service

The Service

1. Greet and Visit with those you have come to serve.
2. Ask about Celebrations and /or Concerns (include in prayer).
3. Read the Prayer of Confession and Pardon (from the bulletin).
4. Serve Communion (I Corinthians 11:23-26 *The Message*).

The Bread:

*The Master, Jesus, on the night of his betrayal took bread
Having given thanks, he broke it and said:
“This is my body broken for you. Do this to remember me.”

The Cup:

*After supper, he did the same thing with the cup:
“This is my blood, my new covenant with you.
Each time you drink this cup, remember me.”

After the Cup say:

*What you must solemnly realize is that every time you eat this bread
and every time you drink this cup, you reenact in your words and actions
the death of the Master, Jesus.

5. Prayer
Read all/part of the Prayer of the Day from the bulletin (or offer your own).
